IMPACT Update: Twelve people from our congregation joined about 1,000 others this past Tuesday night for IMPACT'S Nehemiah Action to request action from our community leaders to address the issue of affordable rentals in Charlottesville and Albemarle County. The three members of the Albemarle Board of Supervisors in attendance, agreed to work with their board members to try to dedicate some of the Housing Fund revenue to be used to create 150 units for low income seniors over the next five years. The Assistant City Manager and Chair of the Charlottesville Housing Advisory Committee also agreed to the Impact requests, which are to try to streamline the process for approving site plans for projects that provide some affordable housing. They will also work with the Neighborhood Development Services and the Planning Commission to review the current zoning code, looking for ways to incentivize developers to build church retreat to attend the meeting on Tuesday!
