

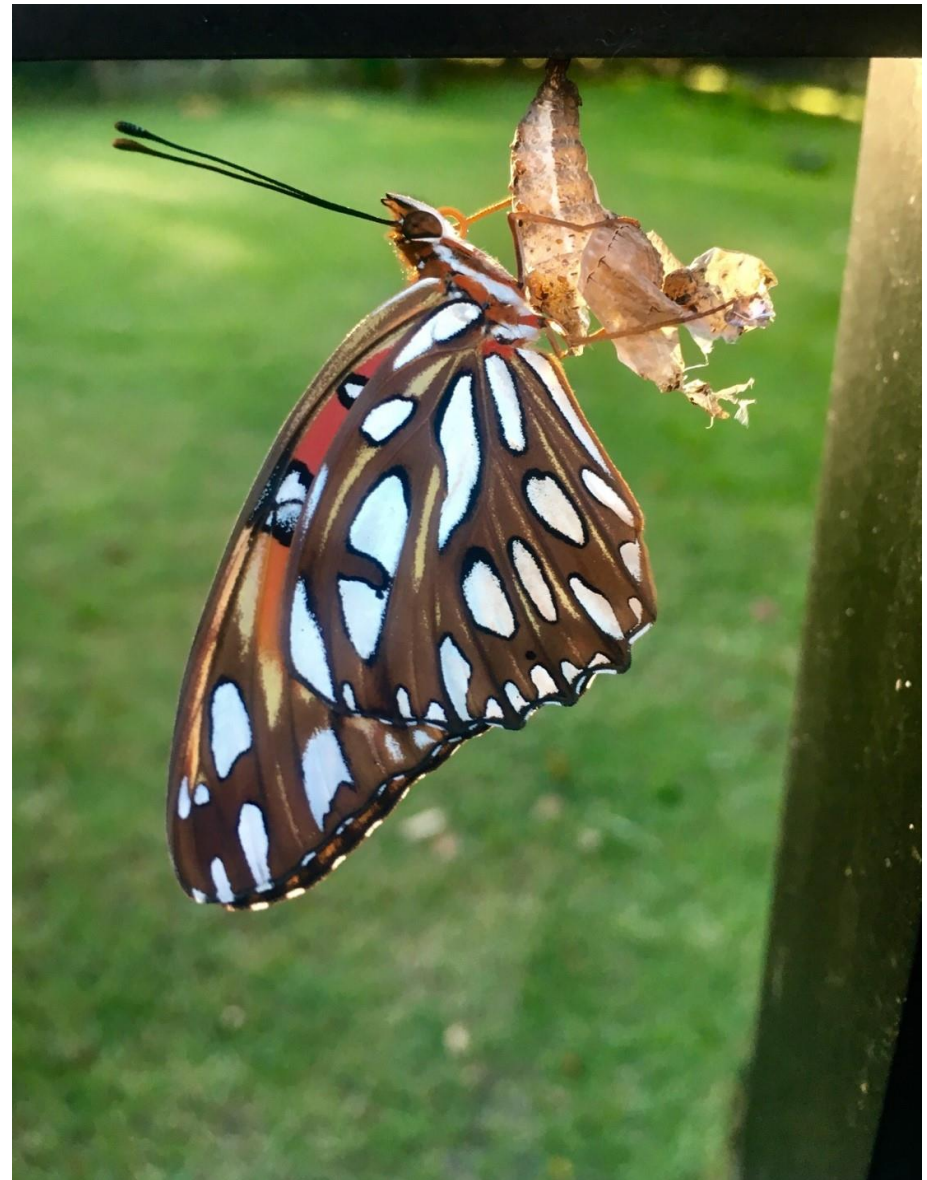
Prayers and Praises
