This week's candle is lit for Mennonites in Albania. Albania is home to the Lezha Academic Center founded in 2011 and one Mennonite congregation of about 120.

Albania Earthquake Relief Fund: On November 26, a 6.4 magnitude earthquake hit Albania, causing loss of life and damage to buildings, including the town of Lezhe, where VMMissions has a number or workers and ministries. Thankfully, our workers were physically unharmed, but they are dealing with the trauma of the event. Lezha Academic Center (LAC), the local Christian school we support, suffered structural damage and will remain closed until the new year. VMMissions is establishing an Albania Earthquake Relief Fund to help provide food, lodging, clothing, medicine, counseling, and other necessities in the town of Lezhe.
